



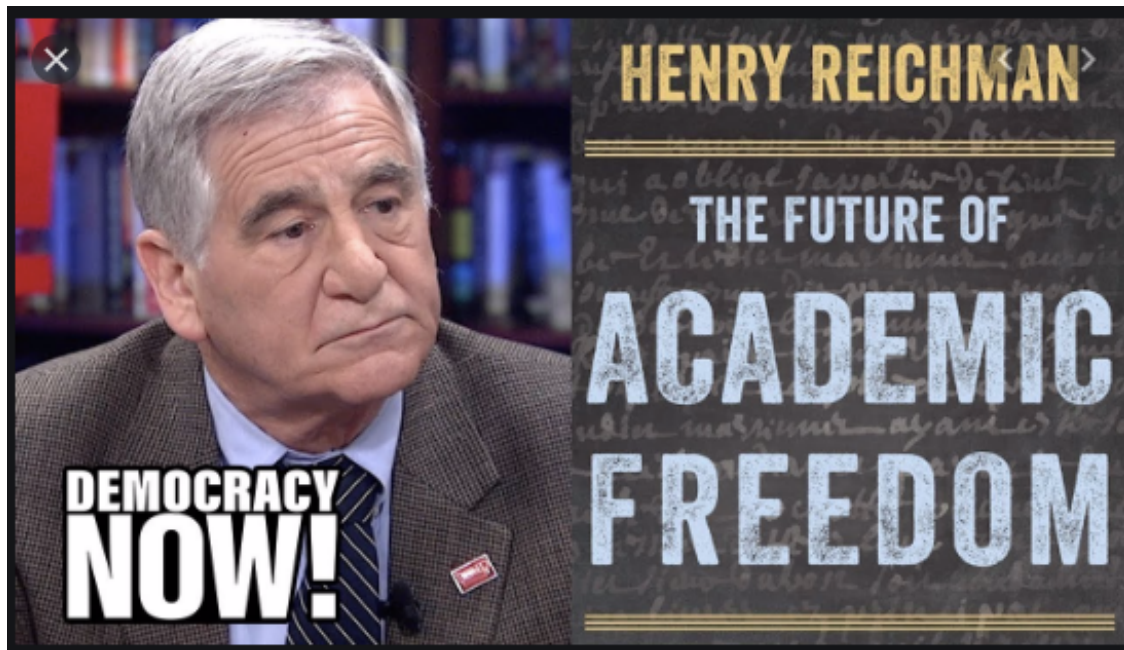

Henry Reichman is Professor Emeritus of History at California State University, East Bay; Chair of the AAUP's Committee on Academic Freedom and Tenure, a position he has held since 2012; and AAUP Second Vice-President. His book, *The Future of Academic Freedom*, was published last year by the Johns Hopkins University Press. A graduate of Columbia University, where he was active in the 1968 student rebellion, he earned the PhD in Russian history at the University of California at Berkeley. From 1982 to 2015 he edited the American Library Association's *Newsletter on Intellectual Freedom* and in that capacity authored *Censorship and Selection: Issues and Answers for Schools*. At CSU East Bay he three times chaired the academic senate and served for nine years on the California Faculty Association collective bargaining team.
